









Order History

- In the “History” tab, order history is available. Standard profile setting is 12 weeks of order history.
- Each order in this screen can be reviewed in detail by clicking on the invoice #.
- In addition, orders in history can be saved as a template if the user would like to duplicate an order and resubmit it as a new purchase.
- Applied credit’s can also be viewed in this section.

Rapid Orders

- In the “Rapid” tab, users can create an order very quickly by simply placing item code and quantity in form boxes and the items are placed into an order pending submission.



Order Bookings

- The “Booking” tab allows you to view bookings being sent in a date range and provides details including ship date, item code, order quantity, unit and extended price.

Account

- A statement of the customer's account is displayed with details including account ID, terms, current balance, remaining balance, and a breakdown of past due balances that are 30, 60, 90, and 120 days over terms.
- Corporate accounts are able to look into each individual store account balance as well as view corporate wide totals and balances.



Retail

- In this section, users are able to create “Retail Definitions” by sales class. This is a powerful tool that allows the user to change and manage retail prices to charge the consumer. Existing definitions can be viewed or modified and new definitions can be created from this same section
- For example if a user wanted to create a retail definition for sales class 026 (Counter Snacks), the user can browse the sales classes, make the sales class selection and then edit its retail profit margin and/or markup. Variables for the type of retail definition created (MSRP, Cost+%, Cost+\$, or Fixed \$), the amount and type of markup, rounding up/down to a set digit for cents in price, U/M selected, primary sell unit for sale, and invoice price display settings are all available in this section.
- Corporate users are able to set retail definitions for an entire chain, individual store specific retails, and/or by zone. All other features are concurrent with those listed above in the example.
